## 1. Enrolment application

An Enrolment Application fee is payable if enrolment is confirmed. This fee will be included in the first invoice issued in conjunction with the Written Agreement. Sibling discounts may apply on this fee, and this will be discussed at the enrolment interview.

All applications for enrolment to the College must be accompanied by supporting documentation for international students on a 500 student visa.

## 2. Tuition fees

Tuition fees include all aspects of compulsory school and teaching costs such as:

- Full Tuition
- Subject Levies
- Textbook usage charges
- Compulsory camps & excursions
- Locker hire
- Laptop/IT device hire in accordance with hire agreement

Tuition fees are charged by the semester and there are two semesters per year. Payment for tuition fees are required by the due date which is the first day of each semester. Tuition fees are valid to the end of 2018. Students will not be permitted to commence a new semester while all or part of the previous semester's fees remain unpaid. One full semester's notice of a student's departure must be given in writing to the Head of School. Where less than 20 weeks' notice of withdrawal is received, the College will refund the amount of unused tuition fees less a maximum of ten weeks' tuition fee. (Refer to the refund policy on our website).

## 3. Non tuition fees

Homestay fees are payable before the commencement of the semester. A one off Homestay Placement fee is charged in the first semester's homestay fees. Homestay fees will be invoiced per semester. Students who remain in homestay over the Christmas/Summer vacation will be required to pay an additional homestay fee.

Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) is compulsory and cover must be taken out for the full length of the student's course before the student visa will be issued. The college will require a copy of the OSHC policy from the student prior to commencement.

Uniforms are to be purchased by the student prior to or on the first day of school. A formal day uniform, sports uniform and hat are required for all year levels. All uniforms must be purchased from the Groves Uniform Shop. A copy of the current uniform price list can be found on our website [Groves Christian College](#). The price given in the table above is indicative only and it is at the discretion of the student as to how many uniform items they purchase.

Textbooks and stationery items are to be purchased by the student prior to or on the first day of school. Pricing will vary depending on the year level and subject choice. The price given in the table above is indicative only and subject to fluctuation. Some textbook and stationery items are available from the college Bookshop; however, you will need to purchase other items from a local stationery supplier. A booklist will be provided to the student upon acceptance of enrolment. Senior Maths students may be required to purchase a Scientific Calculator valued at approximately \$110.

## 4. Other fees

Personal Living Expenses are estimated at \$80 per week. This estimation is for activities the student may wish to engage in outside of school hours. This allowance is a recommendation only. More information on Living and Studying in Queensland is available at [Living Costs in Australia](#).

Groves Christian College bus pick up is offered to students living in local areas. The price given in the table above is indicative only.

Airport Pick Up is provided at no cost to the student only. If family members do accompany the student, they will be required to pay an additional cost. Free Airport Pick Up is only provided from Brisbane Airport.
