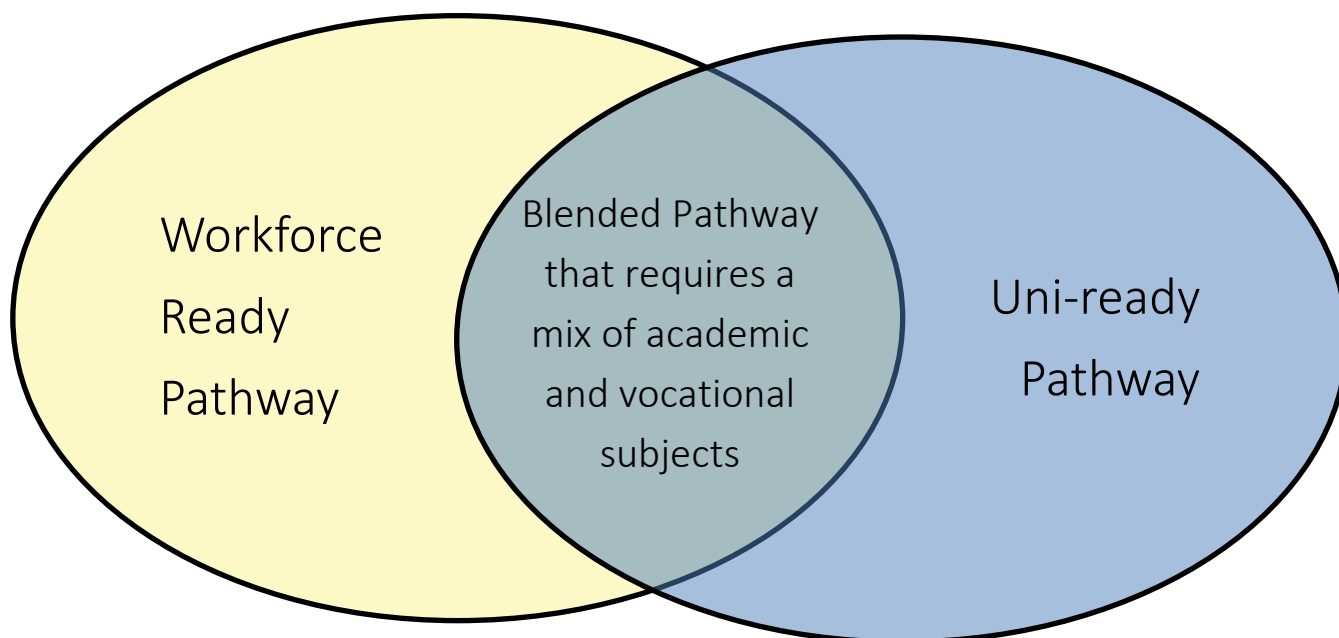
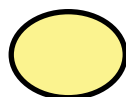


## Pathways explained

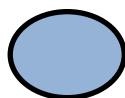


### Workforce-ready



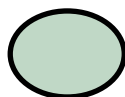
- Will be ready to apply for a job straight after school, e.g. hospitality, building, retail.
- Might undergo further vocational on-the-job- training and certificate courses after school.
- Will be studying Applied subjects and certificate courses in Years 11 and 12.
- Will be doing school-based traineeships and apprenticeships.

### Uni-ready



- Ready for the workforce, but know that tertiary studies at a degree level will be part of their pathway – either full time or part time.
- Wants to enter the workforce in a professional job that requires the higher level of English and Mathematical skills, e.g. working in administration or in a bank.
- Will be studying General academic subjects plus maybe a certificate III or a university course in Years 11 and 12.

### Blended



- Wanting to pursue careers that require a mix of academic and vocational subjects. (At this stage of school, wants to undertake both hands on and theory based subjects).
- Might be students who want to enter a specialist trade e.g. electrician, or a trade in the army. The student is capable of and/or requires subjects that will complement their careers such as Physics or Advanced Mathematics.
- Usually will undertake English rather than English Essentials.
- This group must negotiate their subject selection with Mr Geeves and Mrs Nieuwoudt.
